#### Who is Eligible

  - 9am – 12pm, Saturday, December 14 or January 11

#### How to Apply

- 1) Submit your official Admissions Application to Saint Joseph High School
- 2) Send the completed scholarship application to the Scholarship Committee with:
  - One letter of recommendation from your principal or a teacher
    - *Only one letter of recommendation required if applying for other scholarships*
  - Completed essay (must be typed) you have created on:  
“The Most Significant Event (or Person) in My Life”
