In the event a student is awarded a scholarship, the student must:

- Participate in at least one club/activity at SJHS per semester.
- Commit to volunteering at the student's school, church or community.
- Show a commitment to academic achievement at SJHS.

Follow these steps to apply:

- 1) Submit your official Admissions Application to SJHS or apply online (SaintJosephHS.com).
- 2) Submit the SJHS Record Request Form to your elementary school. Your school will send SJHS your most recent elementary school transcript.
- 3) Take the placement test at SJHS (November 20).
- 4) Send the completed scholarship application to the Scholarship Committee with the following:
 - One letter of recommendation from your principal or a teacher.
 - Completed essay (500 words or less; <u>must be typed</u>) on "Why I want to attend SJHS."
